Woodworkers can come into contact with hazardous chemicals contained in wood treatment solutions, strippers, binders, glues, varnishes or paints. Our coveralls protect against splashes in the form of hazardous dusts or impregnation liquids.

MACHINING

Wood-sawing operations, and especially sanding, generate large quantities of very fine dust. Wood dust is harmful when it comes into contact with the skin. How dangerous it is depends on the type of wood (deciduous, coniferous, exotic). Treated wood contains chemicals such as formaldehyde.

Type 5/6 coverall

Protection against fine wood dust and low concentration chemicals.

Its self-adhesive flap protects the front part of the body during treatments and applications of products with a brush.

UNDRESSING, A RISKY MOMENT

When short-use protective suits are used, there is a high risk of contamination during the operation and when undressing.

The wearer must carefully adjust the suit at the hood, wrists and ankles. When undressing, a strict procedure must be followed to avoid any contact with the outside of the suit.
